

NEWS BULLETIN: FISH AUTOPSY RESULTS

Scientists have just finished examining dead fish found in Gray Bay. Fifty fish were examined. The fish were identified as 24 Steelhead Trout, 11 Coho Salmon, 6 Carp, and 9 Northern Pike.

Some kind of oil was found in the stomachs and intestines of 14 of the fish. 21 fish had clamped fins, which indicates that they died from not enough oxygen. Chlorine was involved in the death of 8 fish, and scientists have not yet determined what killed the other 7 fish.
